Stewardship Options

As the new church year is about to begin and the stewardship drive is in progress, this is to provide you with information about the options available for making offerings to the church.

The first option is by check or cash as you have been doing. Please keep in mind that if you make offerings with cash, and you do not insert it inside an envelope or something else with your name on it, I have no way of knowing who it is from and, therefore, cannot credit your account with the offering. Also, if the check is to be directed to something other than the general fund, please indicate that in the Memo line.

The second option is through the online portal Tithely. The website is https://app.tithely.com/login. If you do not already have an account, you can create one and make offerings through this portal. The charges to use this portal are as follows:

Credit/debit cards: 2.9% + \$.30 per transaction ACH/Bank 1% + \$.30 per transaction Amex 3.5% + \$.30 per transaction

You can generously opt to pay the transaction fee or the church will pay the fee, and it will be deducted from what is deposited into the church's account.

The third option is having money sent directly from your bank. Your bank can send a check monthly to the church in any amount you choose. With this option, you don't have to worry about writing a check every month. Just make sure the bank knows to put your name somewhere on the check or check stub.

The fourth option is for anyone over the age of 70 ½. If you have an IRA and would like to use this IRA to make payments for your offerings, it is a tax savings for you. It is called a Qualified Charitable Distribution. The QCD limit is now at \$105,000, meaning you may donate up to \$105,000 each year directly from your IRA to any charitable organization, and that money is not taxed at the end of the year. So instead of withdrawing the money from your IRA, then writing a check to the church (which makes your withdrawal taxable), talk to your financial manager about sending your offerings directly from your IRA to the church. Also, as with the bank, make sure your financial company knows to put your name somewhere on the check or check stub.

I hope this helps to give you some information and helps you decide which option is best for you! If you have any questions, please let me know.
