The Least of These

The phrase "the least of these" appears in the Bible, specifically in Matthew 25:40, as part of Jesus' discourse about the final judgment. In this passage, Jesus speaks of how acts of kindness and mercy toward those who are considered "the least" in society are seen as acts done unto Him. The phrase carries deep theological and ethical significance, highlighting the importance of caring for the marginalized and vulnerable in the community. It reflects Christ's teaching that loving and serving others, especially those in need, is an essential part of genuine Christian discipleship.
