By the power of God's grace being applied to the believer through the indwelling Holy Spirit, growth is possible even when faced with false teachings and other hardships. At the end of the letter, Peter states that 'according to his promise we are waiting for new heavens and a new earth in which righteousness dwells' (2 Peter 3:13), and then spends the last few verses instructing believers on what to do in the meantime. In conclusion, he says: 'But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ'" (2 Peter 3:18).
